Directions by car to Seton Hall University

1. From the Garden State Parkway North or

South: Take the Garden State Parkway to Exit 145. Follow directions for 280 West.

2. From the New Jersey Turnpke:

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 15W. Follow directions for 280 West.

3. From 280 West:

Take 10, West Orange/South Orange. Proceed to the first light and turn left onto Northfield Avenue. Go three lights and turn left onto Gregory Avenue. Continue straight to the end of Gregory Avenue (Gregory becomes Wyoming Avenue). At the end of Wyoming Avenue, turn left onto South Orange Avenue. Drive through the Village of South Orange; the campus is approximately 1½ miles on the right.

4. From 280 East:

Take Exit 9, Mt. Pleasant Avenue/West Orange/Montclair. Stay on Brennan Drive to the end. Make a right onto Northfield Avenue. Go two lights and turn left onto Gregory Avenue. Continue straight to the end of Gregory Avenue (Gregory becomes Wyoming Avenue). At the end of Wyoming Avenue, turn left onto South Orange Avenue. Drive through the Village of South Orange; the campus is approximately 1½ miles on the right.
