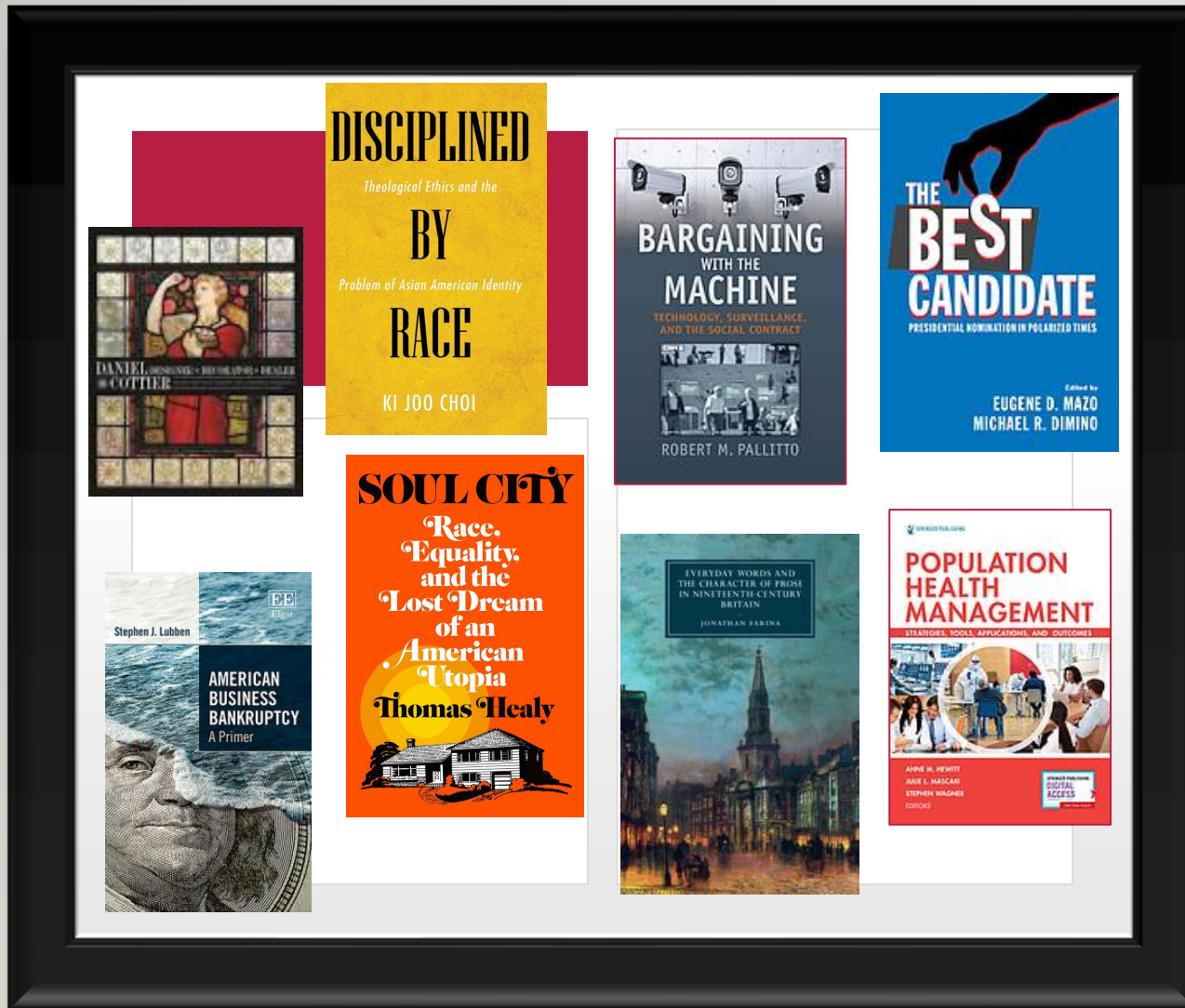

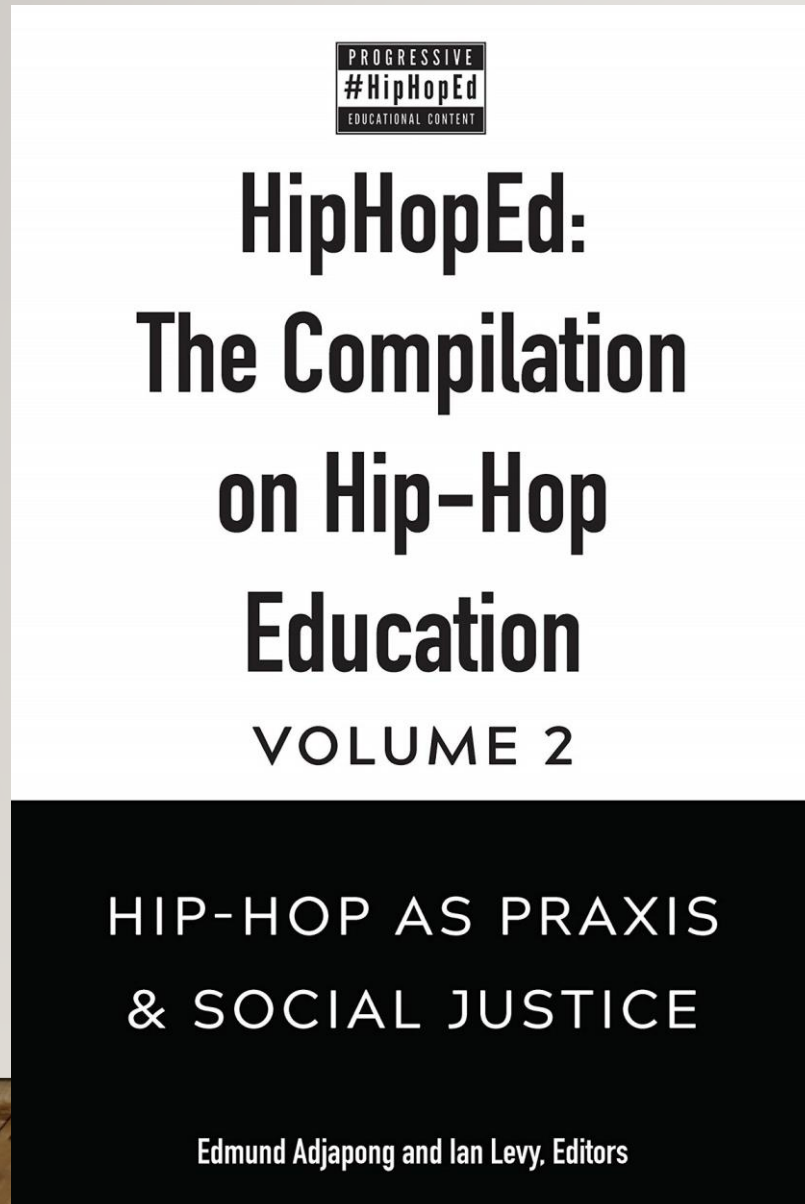

With 9 colleges spanning three campuses, Seton Hall has many written treasures to see at Walsh Library.

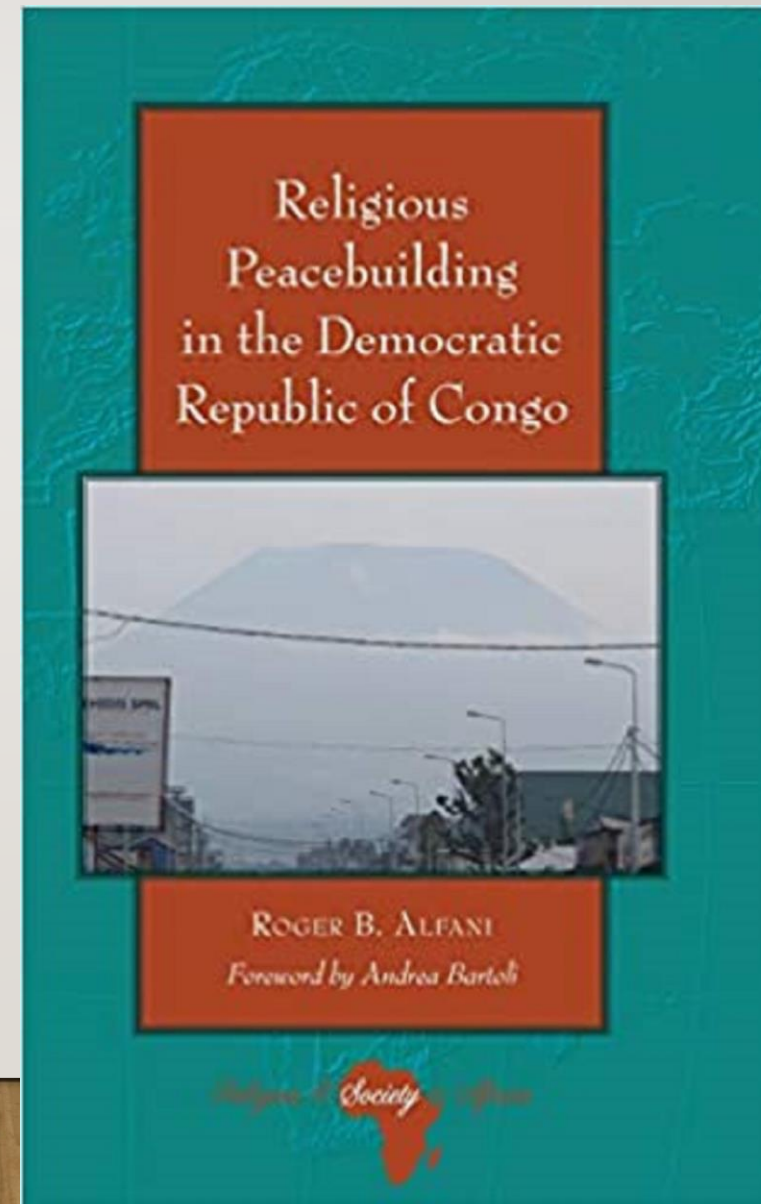
