## Seton Hall University - Retention and Graduation Rate Trends Entering as First-time Freshman



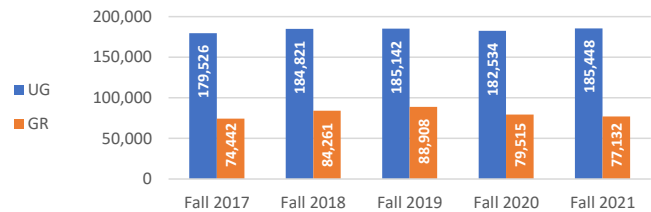
