

A BIBLIOGRAPHY OF ASSOCIATE JUSTICE WILLIAM J. BRENNAN, JR.

This bibliography was compiled to assist legal scholars interested in the career of Justice William J. Brennan, Jr. and his impact on the Supreme Court. The primary bibliography consists of the Justice's published book—a collection of his opinions and three speeches; pamphlets; pieces included in works edited by others; articles, many of which were originally presented as speeches; and unpublished speeches on deposit at the Library of the Supreme Court and at the Institute of Judicial Administration, New York City.

The secondary bibliography, compiled from both legal and popular sources, concentrates upon materials bearing directly upon Justice Brennan or about the relationship between the Justice and the Supreme Court. This list is necessarily selective, but reports the great majority of significant sources available to the lawyer and layman.

The career of Justice Brennan is a long and distinguished one. He has served in private practice in New Jersey, as a colonel in the United States Army during World War II, and as a Judge on the Superior Court and a Justice on the Supreme Court of New Jersey. His career and the record of his family's achievements in New Jersey, both social and political, are recorded in many hundreds of articles in New Jersey newspapers. The *Newark News*, published until 1972, has the most extensive coverage of the Brennan family. Its morgue is on deposit at the Newark Public Library, Newark, New Jersey.
