Minutes of the meeting of Feb 21, 1978. Present: Bishop Dougherty, Fr. Sullivan, Fr. Seymour, Messrs. Mahoney, Prince, Kelly.

The director reported that the application for NEH funding of the Commission's work had been submitted and that the NEA application had been rejected, but the reasons for the rejection were unclear and had to be investigated.

The Commission agreed to move quickly ahead on obtaining the matching funds for the NEH proposal. The director reported President Robert T. Conley's concern that the matching funds be found as soon as possible.

Mrs. Conelli and Peter Wosh, the NYU graduate student/intern are both working in the collections now.

An extensive discussion of membership on the Commission ensued. Bishop Dougherty has written to Sr. Hildegard Marie, S.C., inviting suggestions, but as yet has no reply. Dr. Mitchell will verify the response of Mrs. Miriam Murphy.

Fr. Sullivan requested a meeting in the library so that the commission could view the work on the collections.

The next meeting of the Commission will be on Tuesday, April 4, 1978 at 2:00 P.M. in the AFA Club, basement of President's Hall. Before adjournment, the commission will go to the library to view the work being done.

The meeting adjourned at 3:45 P.M.
