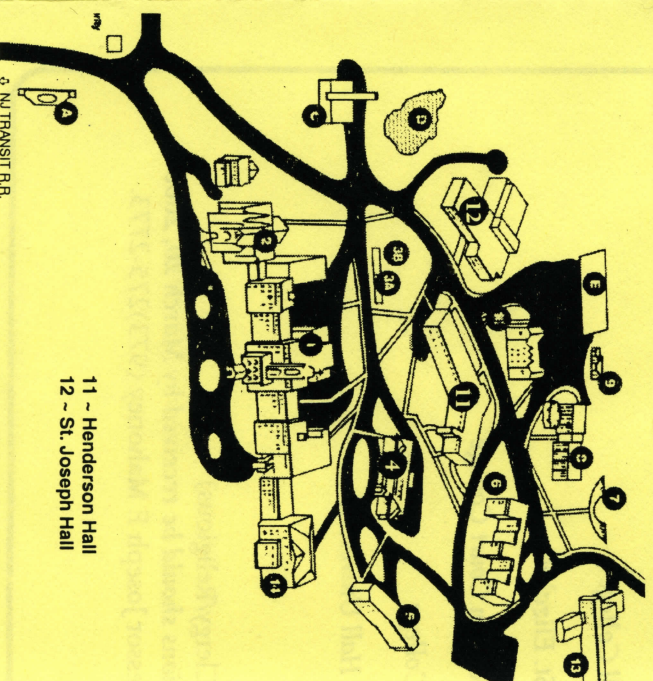
On March 25, 2000 the New Jersey Catholic Historical Records Commission will present a conference on women's Catholic higher education in New Jersey at the College of Saint Elizabeth at Convent Station (Morristown), New Jersey. The College this academic year is celebrating its centennial. It is most appropriate during Women's History Month to recall some of the benchmarks of the development of Catholic higher education in New Jersey. You are cordially invited to join us in reviewing some of the accomplishments of the century.

## Directions to the College of Saint Elizabeth

**From the north:** take I-287 south to Exit 35. (Route 124 [Old Route 24]). At end of ramp, turn left onto Rte 124. Go approximately 1.8 miles to Convent Road (the Madison Hotel is on your left). Turn left onto Convent Road. The entrance to the campus is just across the railroad tracks.

**From the south:** take I-287 north to Exit 35 (Route 124 [Old Route 24], South Street-Madison Avenue). Bear left on exit ramp. At stop sign, turn left onto South Street. Follow South Street one long block to Madison Avenue (Route 124). Turn right onto Madison Avenue. Stay in the right lane until you have passed three traffic lights. At the fifth light (Convent Road. The Madison Hotel is on your left.) turn left onto Convent Road. The entrance to the campus is just across the railroad tracks.
