### Poster Presentations

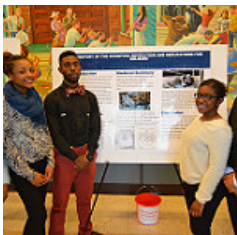
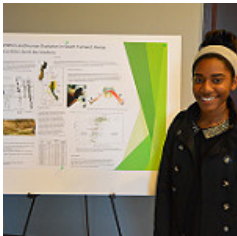

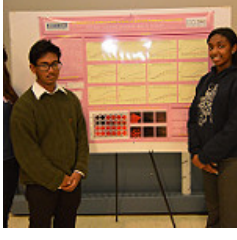
### Oral Presentations
